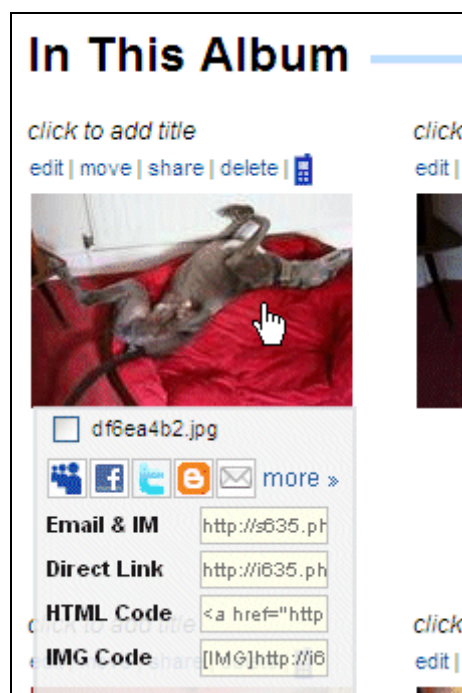

| Adding multiple images to a form message

It is possible to add multiple images to a forum message from an external source. To do this you need to sign up a free account with a Photo Sharing service like Photobucket (<http://photobucket.com>) or similar provider. To display images in the forum from Photobucket, logon to the forum and start your new message, then in a new browser window or tab logon to your photo sharing service to copy and paste your links over. The below screen grab is specific to Photobucket and shows you (once you have an account and have uploaded some pictures where to copy an image link from. Just select an album, then move your mouse over one of the pictures you want to post on the forum.



Note that beneath the picture a series of links are provided, you need to use the last one "IMG Code". Move your cursor down and click on the box next to IMG Code to highlight the link.



Now hold down the CTRL key on your keyboard, and keeping it held down press the letter C. This will make a copy of the link ready for pasting straight into your forum message. Click on the browser or tab for the Greyhoundhomer forum and place the cursor where you want your picture to appear then click on CTRL, and keeping the CTRL button held down press the letter V, this will paste the link into your message. Repeat this for any images you want to display. **This completes this help file, we hope it was useful to you.**
